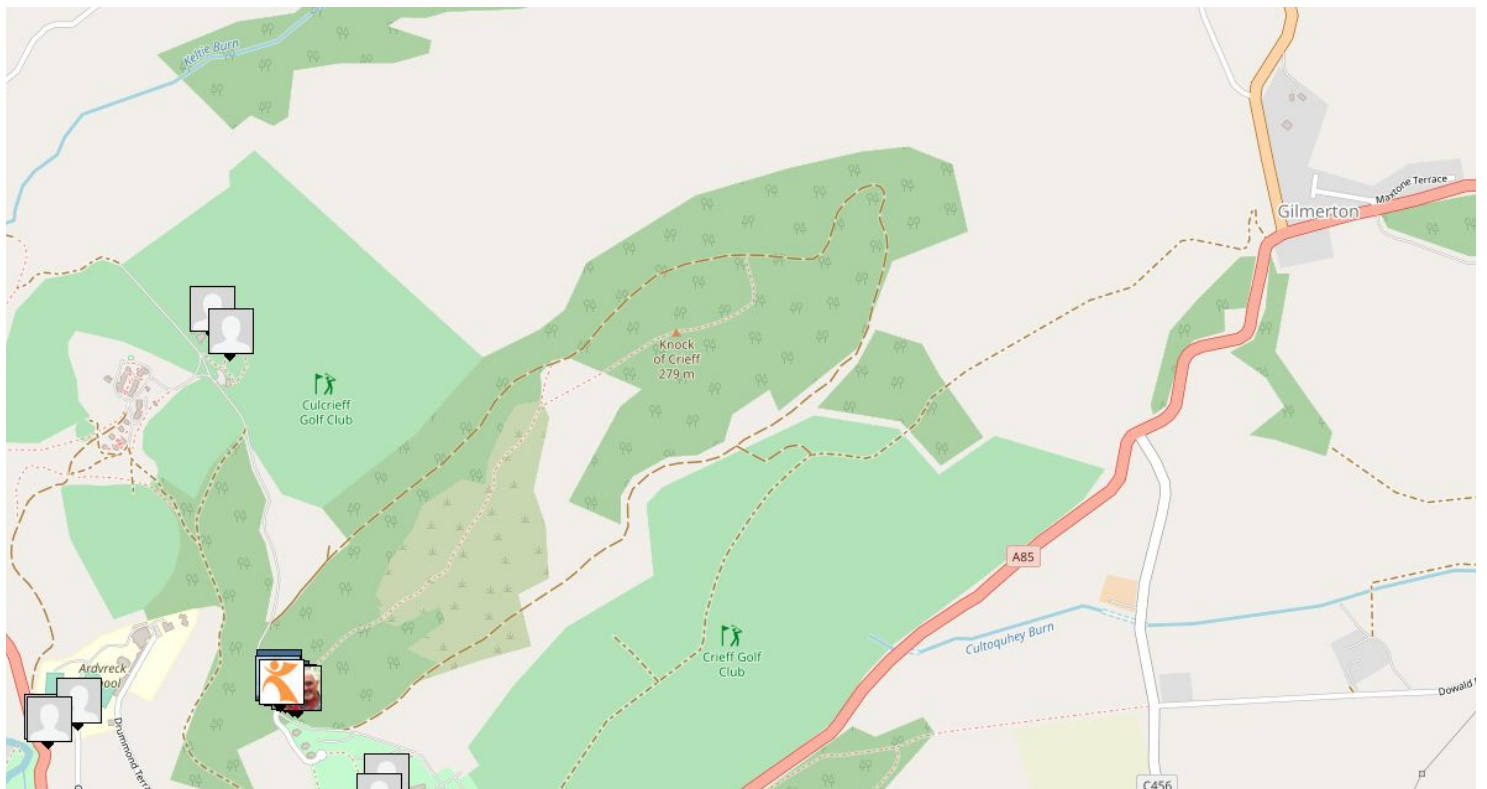


## Walks from Monzie Estate

There are many walks in our beautiful area, here are three that you can do without the need to drive.

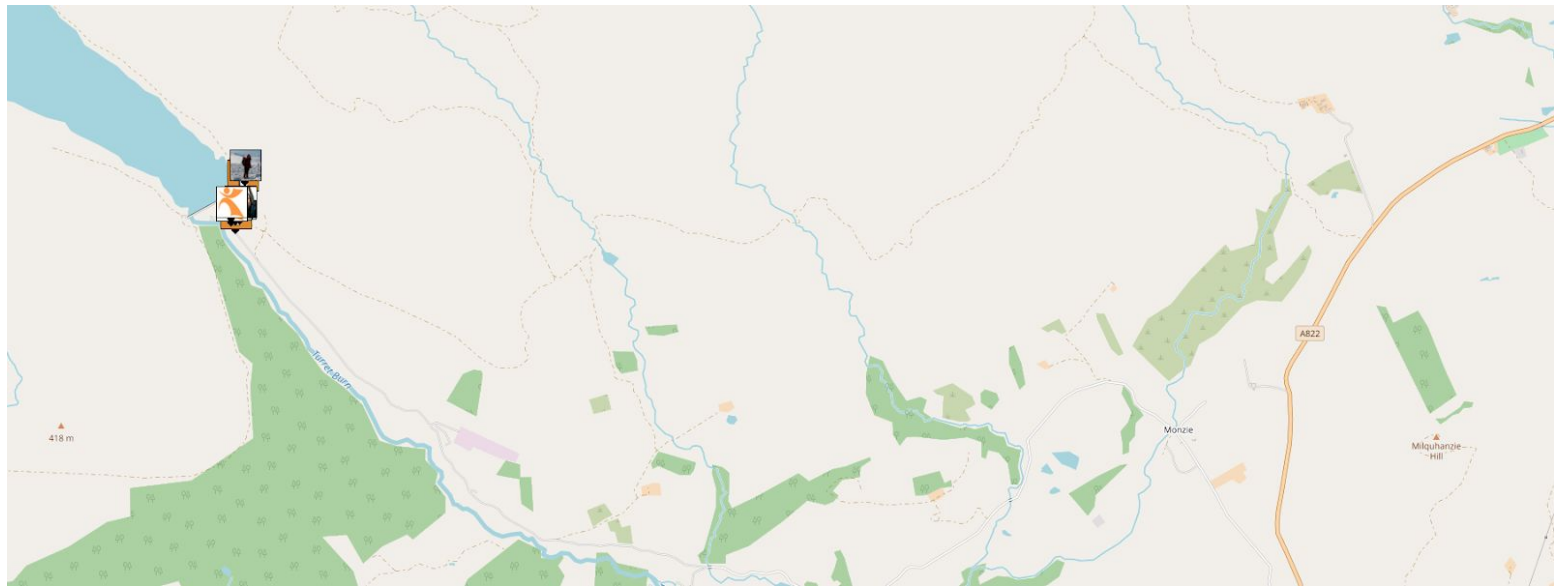
### 1. Knock of Crieff via Gilmerton

Walk from your cottage to Gilmerton - there is a signed path behind the telephone box. Follow this up and you will meet a forestry track which circles the Knock. If you turn right and follow it round you will see the estate from above. Follow signs to the top of the Knock. You can descend via a fairly steep straight path where at the bottom of you turn right you will meet the forestry track again. Follow this around until you see signs for the path to Gilmerton. Time - 2-3 hours depending on whether you walk the whole loop.



## 2. Monzie - Loch Turret Loop

Start on the track next to Monzie bridge and follow this to the top (pictured left). You will need to walk along the A822 for a short distance. You will come to a gated track on the left (below), follow this track. Take a left where tracks meet and keep following the track right to Loch Turret Dam. From there you have the option of walking back the way you came or following the road down to Hosh, there taking a left back to Monzie. This walk is about 10 miles.



## 3. Monzie Circuit

A gentle walk following the tracks and road around Monzie. Starting from your cottage it is possible to do a complete loop back to it. See map. About 5 miles.
